English

In Year 4 we will be covering the following topics: explanation texts, humorous stories and a range of poetry.

Maths

In maths, the children will be learning about place value , the four operations and fractions. The children will also be learning how to tell the time and drawing graphs / interpreting data. The children will continue to learn strategies for problem solving.

ICT

The children will be learning how to develop computer programs. We will also be creating our own leaflets using Publisher.

Geography

This term we shall be continuing to learn about Food and Farming.

History

Science
