

World Book Day is fast approaching and will be held on Thursday 5th March. This year we are planning something a little bit different and I wanted to write to tell you about it.

We will be focusing this year on the Children's book 'The Day the Crayons Quit' by Drew Daywalt. Instead of coming dressed as a story book character, we would like children to come dressed as a colour from a pack of crayons – so, for example, all in red or all in blue.



On the day, we will be completing activities based around this book and hope to have lots of fun learning in the process.

So as not to lose the focus on book characters, we would also like you to work with your children on turning a potato into a book character. There are lots of suggestions if you look online for 'Potato World Book Day Characters', but here are a few examples to get you started. There will be a prize for the best potato character in each class.



We hope this gets you inspired for 'World Book Day 2020 and we look forward with anticipation to seeing which colours and which potato characters turn up to celebrate it with us.

In the week of Monday March 30th to Thursday 2nd April 2020 we will be having a Book Fair in school from Scholastic Book Clubs. The Book Fair will be available at Parents Evenings which fall on Monday 30th March and Wednesday 1st April 2020.
